Mark Yost, President & CEO, Skyline Champion



Mark Yost has more than 25 years of experience in the manufacturing, construction, housing industries. Mr. Yost was appointed Chief Executive Officer and President of Skyline Champion Corporation on June 1, 2019. Prior to the merger of Skyline and Champion, Mr. Yost served as President of Champion Homes (2016 – 2019). Before joining Champion Homes in 2013, he was Executive Vice President and Chief Financial Officer of Severstal North America where he helped run and grow the company from \$1 Bil in sales to \$8 Bil in sales over a few year period while increasing profitability of the company dramatically. He has managed and served on the board of over 20 companies ranging in size from \$250k of revenue to \$8 Bil of revenue. He has studied, built and acquired nearly \$7 Bil of companies to learn what works and what does not by managing them through the downturn and rebuilding them afterwards. He was named Crain's Business CFO of the Year for companies over \$1 Bil in revenue for

leading and developing great teams that rapidly earned market share by always taking care of the customer and offering better products and services.

Mr. Yost has a B.S. in Finance and an MBA from the University of Michigan Ross School of Business and has guest lectured at universities on all aspects of business.

Lesli Gooch, CEO, Manufactured Housing Institute




Lesli Gooch


